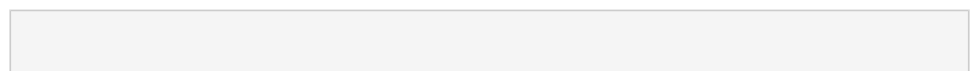

In the Jazz Age-a term Fitzgerald coined-he was regarded as a spokesman for rebellious youth, as a playboy, as an authority on sex and marriage, as an expert on Prohibition, and as an immensely popular writer for his work published in the *Saturday Evening Post*. Yet his literary ambitions were sizable and his impact on American fiction immeasurable.
