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This all-new rhymed bilingual edition of *The Cat in the Hat* is the perfect introduction for Spanish-speaking children to the wonderful world of Dr. Seuss. Now in a larger size trim to accommodate the English and the Spanish text, the new translation was written by Puerto Rican poet and children's book author Georgina Lázaro, and by Teresa Mlawer--one of the most respected figures in Spanish publishing. This new rhymed translation retains the fun of the original text, so that both Spanish-speakers and English-speakers can enjoy reading Dr. Seuss story in two languages.

About the Author

THEODOR SEUSS GEISEL--aka Dr. Seuss--is one of the most beloved children's book authors of all time. From *The Cat in the Hat* to *Oh, the Places You'll Go!*, his iconic characters, stories, and art style have been a lasting influence on generations of children and adults. The books he wrote and illustrated under the name Dr. Seuss (and others that he wrote but did not illustrate including some under the pseudonyms Theo. LeSieg and Rosetta Stone) have been translated into thirty languages. Hundreds of millions of copies have found their way into homes and hearts around the world. Dr. Seuss's long list of awards includes Caldecott Honors for *McElligot's Pool*, *If I Ran the Zoo*, and *Bartholomew and the Oobleck*, the Pulitzer Prize, and eight honorary doctorates. Works based on his original stories have won three Oscars, three Emmys, three Grammys, and a Peabody.

TERESA MLAWER is a pioneer in Spanish-language publishing in the United States. She has translated over 300 children's books from English to Spanish. Teresa has dedicated her life to the cause of literacy, especially among Hispanic children in the US and Latin America. As a well-known specialist in children's literature, she works with publishers, educators, and librarians to bring the best literature, whether authentic or in translation, to the attention of Hispanic children and young adults.

GEORGINA LÁZARO, a native of Puerto Rico, is the author of many books in Spanish for children. Her books have received numerous awards, including the 2010 Pura Belpré Honor Book for Federico García Lorca. The same year, the Association for Library Services to Children, part of the American Library Association, named this book one of the most notable books for children. Georgina has translated many books written in verse from English to Spanish, among them Shel Silverstein's book *Every Thing On It*.

THEODOR SEUSS GEISEL, conocido como Dr. Seuss, es uno de los más queridos autores de literatura infantil de todos los tiempos. Empezando por *The Cat in the Hat* hasta *Oh, The Places You'll Go!*, sus inolvidables personajes, historias y estilo artístico han ejercido una profunda influencia en varias generaciones de niños y adultos. Los libros que escribió e ilustró bajo el nombre de Dr. Seuss (y otros de los que fue autor, pero no ilustrador, utilizando otros seudónimos como Theo, LeSieg and Rosetta Stone) han sido traducidos a más de treinta lenguas. Cientos de millones de ejemplares han llegado a los hogares y corazones de la gente de todo el mundo. La lista de reconocimientos y premios concedidos a Dr. Seuss incluye la Mención de Honor del Caldecott por *McElligot's Pool*, *If I Ran the Zoo* y *Bartholomew and the Oobleck*, el Premio Pulitzer y ocho doctorados honoris causa. Obras basadas en sus historias originales han recibido tres Óscares, tres Emmys, tres Grammys y un Peabody.

TERESA MLAWER es una pionera en el campo de libros en español en Estados Unidos. Ha traducido más de 400 libros infantiles y juveniles del inglés al español. Teresa ha dedicado gran parte de su vida a la causa de la alfabetización, especialmente con niños hispanoamericanos en Estados Unidos y en Latinoamérica. Como reconocida especialista de literatura infantil y juvenil, colabora con editores, educadores y bibliotecarios para poner en manos de niños y jóvenes hispanos los mejores libros, ya sean escritos en español o traducidos.

GEORGINA LÁZARO, nacida en Puerto Rico, es autora de muchos libros para niños, en español. Sus libros han recibido numerosos premios, entre ellos la Mención de Honor de Pura Belpré en el 2010, por su libro *Federico García Lorca*. Ese mismo año, la Asociación de Bibliotecarios que proveen servicios a los niños,

parte de la Asociación de Bibliotecarios Norteamericanos, seleccionó este libro como uno de los libros más importantes para niños. Georgina ha traducido muchos libros, escritos en verso, del inglés al español, entre ellos el libro de Shel Silverstein, *Every Thing On It*.

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
